

### Dress Code:

Our location is incredible!!! We will be at the Murietta Hot Springs Christian Conference Center. The facility is perfectly suited for a camp of our size and we know that God is going to do some great things while we are there.

As always, we want to remind you about the dress code for camp. Please see below for a reminder about what and what not to wear.

One of the unique aspects of this facility is that they have naturally occurring hot springs located throughout the property, as well as a great swimming pool.

During the free time each day, all of our campers will have access to the hot springs and pool, if they wish. However, to keep our maintain the purity of the campers, **we are asking that everyone, both boys and girls, wear long board shorts and swim shirts or rash guards.** Please see the following pictures as examples of what is acceptable for both the hot springs and the pool.

When we are NOT in the hot springs or pool, we will still have our traditional dress code, outlined below.

And again, because we are a Christian camp, the standard for dress is a higher standard than any of us are used to seeing these days, so we felt it would be beneficial just to give a reminder of the basic code. Our goal is to provide one week in the kids' lives where they do not have to be bombarded with inappropriate billboards, sexy advertising, and scantily clad images, so that they can more easily focus on God. Our expectation is radical modesty, with the goal being love and consideration for the other counselors and campers.

With that in mind, please remember the following are not allowed:

- **Short shorts - please keep them just above the knee. (Athletic shorts should have short "leggings" underneath)**
- **See through shirts**
- **Backless, strapless, off the shoulder shirts that cause the bra to show**
- **Spaghetti straps or bralettes**
- **Low cut, cleavage exposing shirts**
- **Also if girls are going to wear yoga pants/leggings, we are requiring that they wear a shirt that reaches the mid thigh in front & back**
- **In addition, we are asking that the boys refrain from wearing muscle tanks**

We realize that this may be a different standard than your home, or your home church. However, this is the standard of the camp. Please help us create a sexually pure environment for the campers that is focused on the "spirit" rather than the "law". We will not have measuring tapes out trying to decipher if shorts are too short. However, those with questionable shorts/leggings will be asked to change. If the camper has no longer shorts in their suit case, they may borrow from a friend. Or if all else fails, you will be asked to bring them appropriate clothing.
