WHAT TO BRING

- Pillow and Sleeping Bag (Beds Are Provided)

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Electronics (iPods, PSPs, etc)
- Phones: All phones will be collected during registration.
- Over-the-Counter Medication: Advil, Tylenol, Claritin, Sudafed. *These will be provided by camp.*

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Each camper will be responsible for their own belongings. The camp is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Registration does *not* begin until 2PM, so if your child is not coming on a bus then please bring them after 2PM.
- Every camper is to remain in the camp during the entire program.
- Any camper driving must check their keys in at registration. They will receive them back at the end of teen camp.
- Any parents who take their child off campus must sign them out with the camp administrator before doing so.
- Only registered campers are allowed at camp. Any visitors must register with the camp administrator.

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

Bringing any of the following items is a cause for immediate dismissal from camp:

- Drugs, alcohol and tobacco products
- Weapons of any kind
- Sexual Impurity

DRESS CODE LETTER

Hi teen camp parents, counselors and staff!

This is just a reminder about the dress code for teen camp. Because it is a Christian camp, the standard for dress is a higher standard than any of us are used to seeing these days, so we felt it would be beneficial just to give a reminder of the basic code. Our goal is to provide one week in the kids' lives where they do not have to be bombarded with inappropriate billboards, sexy advertising, and scantily clad images, so that they can more easily focus on God. Our expectation is radical modesty, with the goal being love and consideration for the other counselors and campers. With that in mind, please remember the following are not allowed:

- Short shorts: Please keep them just above the knee. Athletic shorts should have short "leggings" underneath.
- Yoga pants or leggings: We require a shirt that reaches the mid thigh in front and back.
- Low cut, cleavage exposing shirts.
- See-through shirts and spaghetti straps.
- Backless, strapless, off the shoulder shirts that cause the bra to show.
- In addition, we are asking that the boys refrain from wearing muscle tanks.

We realize that this may be a different standard than your home or your home church. However, this is the standard of the camp. Please help us create a sexually pure environment for the campers that is focused on the "spirit" rather than the "law". We will not have measuring tapes out trying to decipher if shorts are too short. However, those with questionable shorts/leggings will be asked to change. If the camper has no longer shorts in their suit case, they may borrow from a friend or if all else fails, you will be asked to bring them appropriate clothing. Thank you for your help and support!
